The \$25,000-added JB Quarter Horses Futurity will be held November 9-12, 2011, in conjunction with the 2011 Elite Barrel Racing Big Cash Getaway at the Heart 'O Texas Coliseum in Waco, Texas. The Futurity, for 5-year-old and under horses will have \$20,000 in added money and offer one \$5,000-added Amateur Incentive.

Entry fees for the Futurity are \$300 with an 80% payback. The unique format will include a qualifying round on Thursday, November 10, 2011, and two finals. The fastest 50% of the runners in the qualifying round will compete for 60% of the purse money in the clean-slate Championship Round, Saturday, November 12, 2011. The remaining half of the field, including those with hit barrels and no times, will compete for the 40% of the purse in the clean-slate Consolation Round on Friday, November 11, 2011.

The Amateur Incentive has an entry fee of \$100 with a 100% payback. The incentive will be paid out on a total time of both their runs. Amateur riders must have a 2011 Amateur Card from the AQHA, APHA, or ApHC and must present their current card to collect winnings.

FAQ and Rules

1. What is the Futurity Payment Schedule?

September 15 (*nomination fee*) \$175
October 15 \$175
TOTAL \$350

Total \$350 fee includes the Entry Fee and \$50 Processing Fee. (*Stall fee is not included*)

A photocopy of the front and back your horse's papers is required when the entry form is sent into Elite Barrel Racing.

2. What are the Late Fees?

If the September 15, 2011 nomination date is not paid, you may still enter a horse by October 15, 2011 with a \$50 late fee. If no payments are paid by October 15, 2011, you may still enter a horse, but must do so by October 30, 2011 and pay a \$100 late fee. No entries will be accepted after October 30, 2011.

3. When do the incentive entries have to be paid?

The incentives must be paid by October 30, 2011 without a late fee. You may enter an incentive from October 30, 2011 to November 7, 2011, but must pay a \$25 late fee.

4. Who can enter the Amateur Incentive?

Amateur riders must have a 2011 Amateur Card from the AQHA, APHA, or ApHC and must have their current card on file with the show secretary BEFORE their run to collect winnings. Copies of your card should be included with your entry or may be faxed or mailed to the office. AQHA rules will be followed. That is, if you have an Amateur Card, but do not meet the AQHA's Amateur Requirements, you are not eligible for this incentive. Amateur Cards must be presented to collect winnings.

5. Do I have an Elite Barrel Racing membership to run in the JB Quarter Horse Futurity?

Elite Barrel Racing does not require any memberships. However, the horse owner must complete a Winner's Form, which includes their social security number, before any checks will be awarded.

6. Does the Futurity horse owner or rider have to qualify to run in the Elite Barrel Racing Big Cash Getaway?

Elite Barrel Racing does not require any horse owner or rider to qualify to run in this race.

7. Can I carry over my time from the Futurity to the Elite Barrel Racing Big Cash Getaway?

No, you cannot carry over your time from the Futurity to the Elite Barrel Racing Big Cash Getaway.

8. What if I miss my payment to JB Quarter Horses?

If monthly payments are not received in the office by the due date or do not contain the late fee, if applicable, your entry will be pulled without further notice and will not be reinstated. NO REFUNDS will be awarded for delinquent entries. Refunds will only be awarded to anyone that has paid in advance or in full. Note that the only money that will be refunded is the money for the payments that have not met their due dates.

9. What horses are allowed to compete in the JB Quarter Horse Futurity?

Horses may compete in the JB Quarter Horse Futurity if they were foaled in the year 2006 or after. The horse must not have been competed on in a barrel race prior to December 1, 2010. This also includes divisional races, registered shows, barrel races, play days, or rodeos.

10. What if the ownership changes for a horse after it is entered?

Written authorization must be received from the original owner stating that he/she has sold the horse before any entries can be transferred to the new owner.

11. Can I draw a horse out of the Futurity?

You may draw out a horse at anytime from the Futurity, however, you will not be refunded any entry fees.

12. Can I substitute a horse in the Futurity?

Yes, you may substitute a horse for a fee of \$10. Horses must belong to the same owner. All substitutions must be completed by November 4, 2011.

13. Can I substitute a rider?

Yes, you may substitute a rider for a fee of \$10. Horse must belong to the same owner. All substitutions must be completed by November 4, 2011.

14. How will this Futurity be run?

All Futurity entries will make their first run on Thursday, November 10, 2011. The fastest 50% of the runners in the qualifying round will compete for 60% of the purse money in the clean-slate Championship Round, Saturday, November 12, 2011. The remaining half of the field, including those with hit barrels and no times, will compete for the 40% of the purse in the clean-slate Consolation Round on Friday, November 11, 2011.

15. When can we check in our Futurity horses?

You may arrive in Waco starting Wednesday, November 9, 2011. Check in for Futurity horses will be at the stall office on Wednesday, November 9, 2011. All entries will be mouthed for age verification. All futurity horses must be checked in by 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2011. If your horse is not checked in on time, you will be disqualified. Original papers are required to check in. All registered and unregistered horses are welcome, but unregistered horses must have a signed affidavit from a veterinarian stating the horse's age.

16. When can we start checking into our Stalls and RVs?

Upon your arrival we ask that you please check in at the Stall Office to receive your stall and RV assignments. Stalls and RVs will be sold starting Wednesday, November 9, 2011 through Saturday, November 12, 2011. Stalls cost \$20 per night and RVs \$25 per night.

17. Will there be exhibitions at this Futurity?

Please keep checking for additional information regarding exhibitions.

18. What is the dress code?

All contestants must wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, Western Hat (*minimum 2 1/2" brim*), and cowboy boots or equestrian sport shoes. Caps are not permitted. NOTE: If the hat falls off and lands in the alleyway or arena, a \$10 dress code fine will be assessed. Helmets are not required but all contestants are encouraged to wear one. Anyone not wearing the proper attire in the arena will be assessed a \$10 fine. All fine money will be going to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.

19. Sportsmanship

All contestants and their family members are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. No level of abuse toward any animal at this event will be allowed. Foul language, misconduct or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel will result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of entry fees. Contestants are also responsible for traveling companions and their family members.

20. Photos and Videos

Elite Barrel Racing Productions photographs and video tapes each contestant's individual run. These photos/videos are the property of Elite Barrel Racing Productions and decisions made by Elite Barrel Racing Productions management as a result of viewing photos and/or video are final.

21. Fines

There are fines at all barrel races because a few people will not follow the rules. The fines are used to persuade them. The management of Elite Barrel Racing Productions does not like the fines, but has found out that they must have them. 100% of all fines will be donated to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital.

22. Returned Checks

There is a \$40 service charge on all returned checks from the bank, for any reason. If a check is not replaced with a cashier's check or money order within 30 days after the check is dated, the contestant will be put on the "ineligible" list.

23. Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

24. Vendors

There shall be no selling of any type of merchandise or professional service on the arena grounds, in stalls, or at trailers without a vendor contract with Elite Barrel Racing Productions.

25. Must be Ready

Contestant shall identify themselves to the Gate Man and be in the holding area five horses before their run. Failure to do so will result in a disqualification. The Gate Man will be located next to the alleyway going into the arena. Contestant's name will be called by the Gate Man three times, if the contestant is not in the arena by the third call, they will be disqualified. Only one horse may be in the alleyway at any time. Remember the three official calls come from the Gate Man not the Announcer.

26. Time Begins

Any time a contestant crosses the starting line, the time will begin.

27. No Time

A “No Time” will be given to the contestant for the following reasons:

- If the contestant “circles” their horse after entering or exiting the arena.
(Definition of the Arena is past the plane of the alley)
- If the contestant misses the barrel pattern.
- If the contestant runs out of turn. It is the contestant’s responsibility to know their draw position.
- If a contestant knocks over a barrel. A “no time” will also be given if a barrel is knocked over and it sets up again on either end. Touching a barrel, including to keep it from falling, is permitted without penalty.
- If the contestant’s horse or rider falls during the run in such a manner as to break the pattern, or if the rider falls off the horse.
- Unable to get horse in arena in 60-second time limit.
- If a horse stops forward motion.

28. Time Limit

If a contestant is in the holding pen and attempts to enter the arena, but is unable to get the horse down the alleyway the gateman, after the second call, will give the rider 60 seconds to enter the arena. At the end of 60 seconds if the horse has not broken the plane at the end of the alleyway into the area the rider will be disqualified. *(The reason for this rule is the safety of the contestant, the other contestants in the holding area and the employees.)*

29. Barrel Moved

If a barrel moved off its marker during competition, the barrel must be reset prior to the next competitor’s run.

30. Horses in Arena

Only one horse may be in the arena, or alleyway, at any time during competition.
(The reason for this rule is the safety of the contestant. Accidents can occur where the assisting horse gets in front of the contestant horse and the contestant horse then decides to go and runs into the assisting horse.)

31. Re-Runs

Re-runs shall be granted if the official and backup timer both fail to work properly, unless a barrel has been turned over resulting in a no-time. If the barrels are not placed properly on their markers, a re-run shall also be granted without any penalties being applied; however, any penalty occurring on the re-run shall result in a no time.

32. Training in Arena

Contestants who are given a “no time,” either for missing the pattern or knocking down a barrel, may complete the pattern. However, show management may, at its discretion, ask a rider who is taking excessive time to train to leave the arena immediately. If such request is not complied with, a \$25 fine may be assessed.

33. Fastest Run Possible

Contestants must attempt to make the fastest run possible. Any obvious attempt to “pull up” or pace their run may result in the following penalties - 1st Offense - Warning, 2nd Offense - \$50 fine, 3rd Offense - one year on the “ineligible” list at Elite Barrel Racing Productions events.

34. Tie for Prizes

If any contestants' times are tied, the prize money will be split equally. Numbered poker chips will be drawn and prizes will be awarded based on the order of highest to lowest, with the highest number receiving the largest prize.

35. Payout Requirements

To receive your money, a completed Winner's Form, including a driver's license/birth certificate is required within 90 days of the event or all monies will be forfeited.

36. Disqualifications

Any act deemed prejudicial to the best interests of the Elite Barrel Racing Productions may result in the disqualification of the contestant, with no refund of entry fees. The contestant may also be placed upon the “ineligible” list of the Elite Barrel Racing Productions. These acts may include but are not limited to the following:

- Using abusive or intemperate language or attempting to threaten, bribe, influence, or harass any contestant, spectator, staff member, or Arena Personnel. Also, any remarks made with the intent to cast aspersions on the character or integrity of an Elite Barrel Racing Productions staff member or management member.
- Moving or attempting to move markers at any time.
- Use of electronic and/or remotely controlled devices to alter the outcome of a run.
- Abuse of a horse in any way.
- Competing while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Misidentifying a horse in any Elite Barrel Racing Productions Barrel Race class.
- Misidentifying a rider in any Elite Barrel Racing Productions Barrel Race class.
- Other conduct that is not in the best interest of the Elite Barrel Racing Productions, or its contestants.
- Failure to make good on a returned check to the Elite Barrel Racing Productions or to any other association which has a cooperative agreement with Elite Barrel Racing Productions on the returned checks.
- The Elite Barrel Racing Productions Management at their sole discretion shall have the authority to disqualify or deny entry to any horse they deem dangerous to the rider, or to other individuals, animals or property.

37. Safety

Safety is a prime objective at this barrel race. If you have a horse that could be dangerous to yourself, other contestants, or other horses, **DO NOT COME TO THIS BARREL RACE.** Any horse or contestant deemed to be dangerous by the management of Elite Barrel Racing Productions will be disqualified and entry fees will not be refunded.

38. Rules

The management of Elite Barrel Racing Productions reserves the right to create any new rule, or modify any existing rule, in order to better the sport or this barrel race.

39. Postponement of Event

Elite Barrel Racing Productions reserves the right to postpone any barrel race due to a natural or manmade disaster. We do not like to put these conditions on any event, but feel it is not fair if only a small percentage of barrel racers can attend. Any monies collected will be refunded. If any event is postponed, we will reschedule it for a future date. No postponement, or cancellation, will be made due to a lack of entries.
